



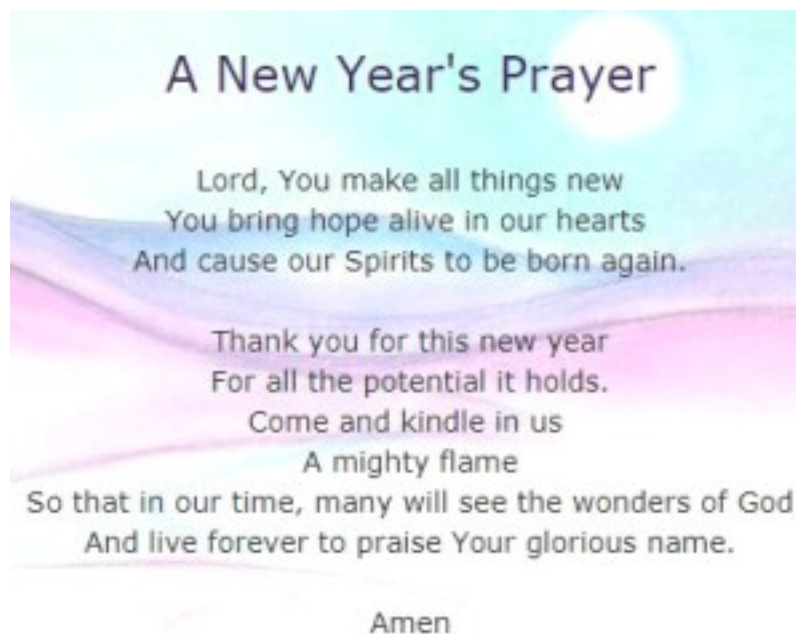
Christ the King Catholic School Advisory Council Meeting from Monday January 16, 2022 5:30 – 6:30 PM
