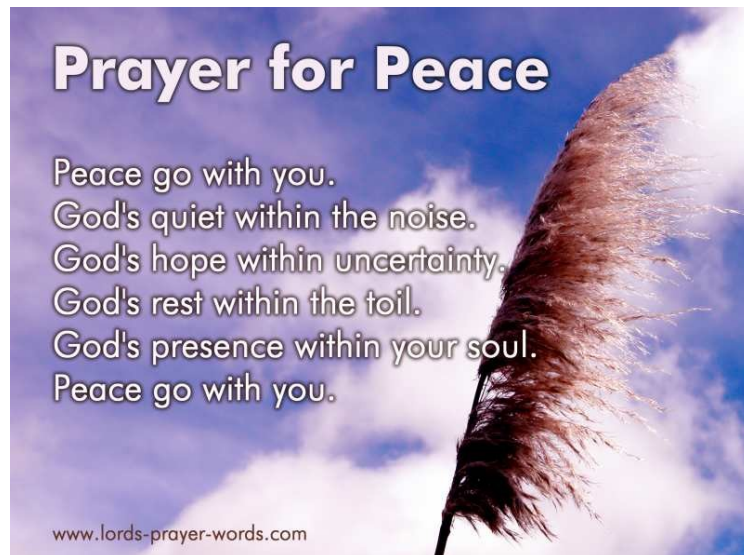
General Meeting

1. Welcome, land acknowledgement and opening prayer:

We would like to acknowledge that the land on which we gather today is the traditional home of the Haudenosaunee, Anishinaabe and Neutral People. We acknowledge the enduring presence and deep traditional knowledge, laws and philosophies of the Indigenous Peoples with whom we share this land today. We seek a new relationship with the Original People of this land, one based on honour and deep respect. We are grateful for the opportunity to learn here and reaffirm our collective commitment to make the promise and the challenge of Truth and Reconciliation real in our community.



1. Brief review of minutes from last meeting held in January

- Discuss Shrove Tuesday: Council bought 4 bags of pancake mix and 4 jugs of Maple Syrup – we have 5 – 7 moms available to help make and distribute pancakes – meeting time is 730am in the kitchen and carts will go to each classroom to distribute – NewsWire sent to ask for students to

bring their tupperware and cutlery for that day. So far \$107 spent – any leftover not opened leftover will be returned – final value will be disclosed next meeting.

- Overview of Plantables: Dianna made an account for CTK – 10% of purchase will come to the school fund – orders are made directly on their website and we can bypass School Cash online – some conditions for the orders will apply – and to offer an option for those that look to place small orders and help with the shipping cost – Dianna will create and manage a generic account that will be placing orders regularly once the minimum order is reached.

2. Principal's Report : we had a visit from the PH nurse assigned to our school Murie V. - she will be working with the school and school community to address areas that are needing support as well as looking to hear all voices within the community that can benefit from the PH programs and tools. We discussed the strengths, voices that might be missing or are being unheard, needs and gaps where the PH programs can come and make a difference. A future visit will be scheduled to have more discussions and next steps.
